17	WHEREAS, the Alachua County Property Appraiser certified the 2017 taxable values to
18	the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida on June 23, 2017.
19	WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires the City Commission to advise
20	the Property Appraiser of its rolled-back millage rate, its proposed millage rate, and of the time,
21	date, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and
22	the proposed tentative budget.
23	WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation
24	within Alachua County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City of
25	Gainesville as \$6,547,912,693.
26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
27	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
28	Section 1. The proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative general
29	purpose municipal budget for the City of Gainesville's 2017-2018 fiscal year is 4.7474 mills.
30	Section 2. The FY 2017-2018 proposed operating millage rate is 4.7474 mills, which is
31	more than the rolled-back rate of 4.2300 mills by 12.23%.
