17 18	WHEREAS, on July 18, 2017, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida
19	adopted Resolution No. 170214 which approved a Proposed Tentative General Government
20	Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville, Florida; and
21	WHEREAS, on July 18, 2017, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 170215
22	approving the proposed millage rate necessary to fund the Proposed Tentative General
23	Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget; and
24	WHEREAS, pursuant to law and utilizing the rate established in Resolution No. 170215,
25	on or about August 15, 2017, the Alachua County Property Appraiser mailed a Notice of
26	Proposed Property Taxes to each taxpayer listed on the current year's assessment roll; and
27	WHEREAS, the said Notice of Proposed Property Taxes advised the recipients of a
28	public hearing to be conducted by the City Commission for consideration of its Tentative
29	General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget and the proposed millage necessary to
30	fund the said budget; and
31	WHEREAS, the public hearing has been held as specified in the Notice of Proposed
32	Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law;

1	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
2	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
3	Section 1. The tentative operating millage rate of 4.7474 mills to fund the Tentative
4	General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville's 2017-
5	2018 fiscal year is hereby approved for further consideration in accordance with applicable law.
6	Section 2. The tentative operating millage rate approved herein is more than the rolled
7	back of 4.2300 mills which results in a 12.23% increase in property taxes.
8	Section 3. A public hearing will be held to consider the final millage rate and the final
9	budget for general municipal purposes on Thursday, September 21, 2017, at six o'clock p.m., or
10	as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the City Hall Auditorium on the first floor of
11	City Hall, 200 East University Avenue, City of Gainesville, Florida.
12	Section 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and publish all
13	necessary and required notices prior to the hearing established herein, and to provide a copy of
14	this resolution to all parties as may be required by law.
15	Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
