 - The Consolidated <u>Annual</u> Performance Evaluation Report (CAPER)



Purpose (CPP)

- Policies and Procedures for citizen participation

 - Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing (AFFH)
- Emphasis on participation of
 - Residents with low/moderate incomes
 - Residents of areas where funds are utilized
 - Residents of predominantly low/moderate income neighborhoods
