Motion: Section 2 (E): The County will consider reinvesting the funds it receives from its reduced College Park/University Heights tax increment contributions into projects of mutual interest such as affordable housing, fire services, eastside development and/or homeless services; 2 (A) Beginning immediately the City and County will begin Joint CRA discussion meetings; 2 (F) It is the intentions of both boards to conclude these discussions September 30, 2018 prior to the 2019 legislative session.

Mayor Poe: What are the goals, purpose and how do we achieve those goals.

Commissioner Ward: At the very highest level - what are we trying to achieve.

Commissioner Arreola: Would like to see a wider geographic area and focus funding on extremely distressed areas in the City.
