3 4	An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, setting March 19,		
5	2019 as the date for the 2019 regular City election and April 30,		
6	2019 as the date for the 2019 run-off election, if necessary; setting		
7	the early voting dates for the 2019 regular city election and 2019 run-		
8	off election, if necessary; setting the dates for qualifying for the 2019		
9	regular election; providing a severability clause; providing a		
10 11	repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.		
12	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-2 of the Code of Ordinances the City		
13	Commission is to adopt an ordinance setting the date of the next regular election by July 1st		
14	of each year; and		
15	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-2 of the Code of Ordinances, the run-off election		
16	is to be held on the sixth Tuesday following the regular election; and		
17	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-10 of the Code of Ordinances the dates for any		
18	person who meets the eligibility requirements described in Article II of the City Charter and		
19	Section 9-10 of the Code of Ordinances to become a candidate for a seat on the City		
20	Commission by filing the necessary qualifying papers with the supervisor of elections shall		
21	run from noon of the 50th day prior to the day of the election to noon of the 46th day prior to		
22	the day of the election; and		
23	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9.6-5 of the Code of Ordinances the City		
24	Commission is to set the early voting dates in the election ordinance adopted annually by the		
25	City Commission; and		
26	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a		
27	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a

of Ordinances, the qualifying dates set forth herein shall govern and control for the 2019
general election.

51	Section 3. If any word, phrase,	clause, paragraph, section or provision of this	
52	ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or		
53	unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the		
54	ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or		
55	application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.		
56	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the		
57	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.		
58	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
