3 4	An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, setting March 19,
5	2019 as the date for the 2019 regular City election and April 30,
6	2019 as the date for the 2019 run-off election, if necessary; setting
7 8	the early voting dates for the 2019 regular city election and 2019 run- off election, if necessary; setting the dates for qualifying for the 2019
9	regular election; providing a severability clause; providing a
10	repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
11 12	WHEREAS, Section 9-2 of the Code of Ordinances requires that in the event the
13	City Commission does not adopt an ordinance setting the date of the next regular election by
14	July 1st of any year, the regular election shall be held on the third Tuesday in March; and
15	WHEREAS, the City Commission did not adopt an elections ordinance by July 1,
16	2018, so this ordinance recognizes that the regular election date is set as Tuesday, March 19,
17	2019 in accordance with City Code; and
18	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-2 of the Code of Ordinances, the run-off election
19	is to be held on the sixth Tuesday following the regular election; and
20	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-10 of the Code of Ordinances the dates for any
21	person who meets the eligibility requirements described in Article II of the City Charter and
22	Section 9-10 of the Code of Ordinances to become a candidate for a seat on the City
23	Commission by filing the necessary qualifying papers with the supervisor of elections shall
24	run from noon of the 50th day prior to the day of the election to noon of the 46th day prior to
25	the day of the election; and
26	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9.6-5 of the Code of Ordinances the City
27	Commission is to set the early voting dates in the election ordinance adopted annually by the
28	City Commission; and

WHEREAS, at least 10 days' notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing in the Auditorium of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held pursuant to the published notice described at which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The 2019 regular election for the City of Gainesville shall be held on Tuesday, March 19, 2019; and, pursuant to Section 9-2(a) of the Code of Ordinances, the date of the run-off election, if necessary, shall be Tuesday, April 30, 2019. The dates for early voting for the 2019 regular election shall be from Saturday, March 9, 2019 to and including Saturday, March 16, 2019. The dates for early voting for the 2019 run-off election, if necessary, shall be from Saturday, April 20, 2019 to and including Saturday, April 27, 2019.

44 Section 2. The dates for any person who meets the eligibility requirements described in Article II of the City Charter and Section 9-10 of the Code of Ordinances to become a 45 46 candidate in 2019 for a seat on the City Commission by filing the necessary qualifying 47 papers with the registration and qualifying officer for the City shall run from noon of the 48 50th day prior to the day of the election to noon of the 46th day prior to the day of the 49 election. Specifically, the qualifying dates shall be from noon on Monday, January 28, 2019 50 to noon on Friday, February 1, 2019. To the extent that the gualifying dates for the 2019 51 general election set forth herein conflict with the requirements of Section 9-10 of the Code

of Ordinances, the qualifying dates set forth herein shall govern and control for the 2019
general election.

Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this 54 ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or 55 56 unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or 57 application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable. 58 Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the 59 extent of such conflict hereby repealed. 60 Section 5.
