PROGRAM LIST REGIONAL TRANSIT SYSTEM

- 1. Achieve average fleet age standard
- 2. Increase fixed-route fixed-scheduled service levels (frequency of service and span of service) to the east side (Routes 2, 3, 7, 11, 27 and 711)
- 3. Identify routes in Number 2 above that can be "interlined" to avid a "forced" transfer.
 - a. This also applies to routes from the west such as Route 75 to be "interlined" with routes that operate to the University and downtown Gainesville, again to avoid a forced transfer.
- 4. Consider weekend service additions to selected campus routes
- 5. Evaluate alternatives to later Gator service using ridesharing options (Lyft, Uber)
- 6. Continue bus stop enhancement program
- 7. Depending on performance expand the RTS 711 service to operate current weekend schedules on weekdays
 - a. Evaluate a more direct route to Rosa Parks Transit Station
- 8. Develop program and services to increase Alachua County, Santa Fe College, and he University of Florida service levels though increased financial participation
- 9. Review UF facilities locations to ensure bus accessibility.
- 10. Seek more diversity and participation among Citizen advisory Board members
- 11. Ensure adequate bus operator and maintenance employee staffing levels through compensation/benefit adjustments to control/reduce turnover and overtime
- 12. Promote more diversity among senior staff
- 13. Consider enhancing selected routes with signal actuation systems (extended green0
- 14. Where multiple routes operate in a corridor (i.e., 13th Street) schedule routes to provide spacing, thus creating more frequent service in a portion of the corridor
