RECOMMENDATION The UAB advise the City Commission to adopt the staff

recommendation of a reduction in the GFT of \$3 million with

an Electric System rate increase of 5% in FY20.

Staff gave presentations on Baseline Budget Rate Review and Rates.

Member Porter made a motion, seconded by Member Alford, to recommend the alternative recommendation. Member Wheeler requested that the maker amend the motion to recommend that whatever GFT reduction they (the Commission) adopt, they adopt the concominant rate increase. Member Porter accepted the amendment but Member Alford did not second. The Board then voted on the original motion and it failed by a vote of 1-5, with members Alford, Wheeler, Jacobson, Selvester and Miles in dissent and Member Rockwell absent.

Member Wheeler then made a motion that the board recommend to the City Commission that they adopt a rate increase that matches whichever GFT reduction they choose, adjusted for total rewards. Member Jacobson seconded and the motion passed 4-2, with members Selvester and Miles in dissent and Member Rockwell absent.

Member Wheeler made another motion, seconded by Member Jacobson, that

in adopting rates, the City Commission recognize that a flat GFT may have a negative rating impact and recognize the need to address customer infrastructure. The motion passed 4-2, with members Selvester and Miles in dissent and Member Rockwell absent.
