#### Bruce A. Blackwell

My early efforts in civic beautification came when R. I. Gov. John Chaffee appointed me to the Green Acres Advisory Committee. We had to pick out lands to be purchased by the State, and by keeping out certain developments did keep an area natural.

At a later time, as the first Executive Director of the Vineyard Conservation Society (<a href="www.vineyardconservation.org">www.vineyardconservation.org</a>) I worked to keep house trailers and other roadside development from occurring. (The VCS, which I started in 1965 is still very active today) and has led to the banning of single-use plastic bags, Styrofoam, plastic straws and in at least three towns single-use plastic bottles holding under 34 ounces.

I became co-owner of the Granary Gallery (<a href="www.granarygallery.com">www.granarygallery.com</a>). We purchased an old barn that had been neglected by an absentee landlord. Although the photos at that website are recent, the look is what we created – always green, mowed lawn and fresh paint. The neighbors were very happy!


In 1977 we took a sow's ear of a house and turned it into a silk purse, quite simply but effectively. The Board of Realtors presented us with an award (attached.)

About 13 years ago we moved to Oak Hammock at the University of Florida. I have been on the Building & Grounds Committee ever since. I an also on the Landscape Long Range Planning Committee and the Greening of Oak Hammock Committee.

I am a frequent speaker at City & County Commission meetings on subjects such as the Styrofoam & single-use plastic bags ban.
