

What problems does LTS solve?

- Individuals with intellectual disabilities are often less likely to enter the workforce due to lack of training and industry skill set.
- Youth and adults in our community lack the life skills, social skills and self advocacy skills to apply, obtain and retain employment.
- Individuals lack experience to adequately build a resume.
- High school graduates with intellectual disabilities often need more education and training to smoothly transition towards societal expectations and demands.



Meet Mirlend

He is a high functioning young man with an intellectual disability, perhaps on the Autism Spectrum. He is brilliant on the computer, but is afraid to interact with people and has several community phobias including fear of crossing streets. He is now 20 and will age-out of school very soon. His parents are not sure what he will do next because he does not want to attend college because of his fear of crowds.



Meet Willie

He is 19 years old and has just graduated from high school. In school, Willie received special education services and had a 1 on 1 aide for all-day supervision. Now that school has ended, his parents are unsure of what to do next.



Meet Selena

She is 27 years old. Ever since high school graduation, she has been unemployed and has never attended college. She mainly stays at home and watches television during the day while her parents are at work. Her parents are concerned that as they age, they will run out of options for their daughter and worry if she will be able to live independently as they grow older.
