11	adopted Ordinance No. 180901 setting the date of the 2020 regular election and run-off
12	election, if necessary; setting the dates of the candidate qualifying period; and setting the early
13	voting dates for the 2020 regular election and run-off election, if necessary; and
14	WHEREAS, Section 1 of Ordinance No. 180901 set the dates for early voting for the
15	2020 regular election from Saturday, March 7, 2020 to and including Saturday, March 14,
16	2020; and
17	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-2 of the Code of Ordinances and Ordinance No.
18	180901, the 2020 regular election is to be held in conjunction with the statewide Presidential
19	Preference Primary election on Tuesday, March 17, 2020; and
20	WHEREAS, the Alachua County Supervisor of Elections has provided notice that the
21	dates for early voting for the 2020 statewide Presidential Preference Primary election shall be
22	from Friday, March 6, 2020 to and including Saturday, March 14, 2020. This Ordinance
23	amends Section 1 of Ordinance No. 180901 to add Friday, March 6, 2020 to the early voting
24	period for the regular election that is to be held in conjunction with the statewide election; and
25	WHEREAS, at least 10 days' notice has been given once by publication in a
26	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
- **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**
- Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 180901 (a non-codified ordinance) is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - Section 1. The 2020 regular election for the City of Gainesville shall be held on Tuesday, March 17, 2020; and, pursuant to Section 9-2(a) of the Code of Ordinances, the date of the run-off election, if necessary, shall be Tuesday, April 28, 2020. The dates for early voting for the 2020 regular election shall be from Saturday, March 7 Friday, March 6, 2020 to and including Saturday, March 14, 2020. The dates for early voting for the 2020 run-off election, if necessary, shall be from Saturday, April 18, 2020 to and including Saturday, April 25, 2020.
  - **Section 2**. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
- Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
