A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF A PERPETUAL EASEMENT TO BE USED FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO IMPROVE STATE ROAD NUMBER SOUTHWEST 62ND BOULEVARD, ARTERIAL CONNECTOR.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation proposes to construct or improve State Road Number Southwest 62nd Boulevard, Arterial Connector, Section Number 26000, F.P. Number 2113657 in Alachua County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an easement across certain lands now owned by the City of Gainesville, Florida, be acquired by the State of Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, said use is in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation has made application to said City to execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation a perpetual easement, or easements, in favor of the State of Florida Department of Transportation, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a roadway construction and long term maintenance and access below bridge, and said request having been duly considered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, that the application of the State of Florida Department of Transportation for a perpetual easement, or easements, is for transportation purposes which are in the public or community interest and for public welfare; that a perpetual easement, or easements, in favor of the State of Florida Department of Transportation in the City of Gainesville in Alachua County, Florida, should be drawn and executed by the Mayor of the City of Gainesville and that this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded forthwith to the State of Florida Department of Transportation at Lake City, Florida.
