A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF A TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT TO BE USED FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION CONSTRUCTION PURPOSES TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO IMPROVE STATE ROAD NUMBER SOUTHWEST 62ND BOULEVARD, ARTERIAL CONNECTOR.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation proposes to construct or improve State Road Number Southwest 62nd Boulevard, Arterial Connector, Section Number 26000, F.P. Number 2113657 in Alachua County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that certain lands now owned by the City of Gainesville, Florida, be used temporarily by the State of Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, said use is in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation has made application to said City to execute and deliver to the State of Florida Department of Transportation a temporary construction easement, or easements, in favor of the State of Florida Department of Transportation, for the purpose of roadway construction, pond construction, and drainage improvements and grading related to roadway construction, and tying in, conforming, harmonizing, and/or reconnecting *existing* grade, slope, pavement, drainage, utility, driveway, walkway, turnout, and/or other features located on or within the real property described below in Alachua County, Florida, with the construction undertaken by the Department on adjacent State Road Number Southwest 62nd Boulevard, Arterial Connector, as part of the above-referenced financial project (collectively the "Reconnection Work"), together with related incidental purposes necessary to complete the Reconnection Work, and said request having been duly considered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, that the application of the State of Florida Department of Transportation for a temporary easement, or easements, is for transportation purposes which are in the public or community interest and for public welfare; that a temporary easement, or easements, in favor of the State of Florida Department of Transportation in the City of Gainesville in Alachua County, Florida, should be drawn and executed by the Mayor of the City of Gainesville and that this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded forthwith to the State of Florida Department of Transportation at Lake City, Florida.
