

Deliverables for Community Clean-up Efforts

27 MCPs to conduct community cleanup efforts. Each program will be awarded \$15,000 to conduct a minimum of 1 cleanup using the funds. The total amount allocated to this portion of the project is \$500,000.00, however, at this time only \$405,00.00 will be allocated. Additional funds can be used as needed.

- MCP will provide itemized receipts of supplies purchased to conduct cleanup events.
- If MCP utilizes funds for personnel costs, MCP will provide table describing the salary and fringe benefits (if applicable) of each employee and number of hours per week employee will be paid using these funds.
- MCP will provide a list of work accomplished such as X number of bags of waste collected, X number of employee or contractor hours, types of waste collected, size of area(s) involved, etc..
- If MCP uses contractors to perform cleanups, the contract agreement must include an itemized list of work performed including X number of bags of waste collected, X number of employee or contractor hours, types of waste collected, size of area(s) involved, etc..
- If funds are utilized for advertisement, MCP must provide what material was disseminated, messaging, and how often advertisement was displayed.

Expenses related to community cleanups include but are not limited to the following: rental of dumpsters, hauling of debris, personnel costs, rental of large equipment for movement of debris (dump trucks, clam trucks, skid steers, crew trucks, etc.), advertisement costs for community cleanup events, and PPE (plastic garbage bags, safety glasses, plastic gloves, aprons, insect repellent, etc.).
