NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE

CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The 2021 regular election for the City of Gainesville shall be held on Tuesday, March 16, 2021; and, pursuant to Section 9-2(a) of the Code of Ordinances, the date of the run-off election, if necessary, shall be Tuesday, April 27, 2021. The dates for early voting for the 2021 regular election shall be from Friday, March 5, 2021 to and including Saturday, March 13, 2021. The dates for early voting for the 2021 run-off election, if necessary, shall be from Friday, April 16, 2021 to and including Saturday, April 24, 2021.

Section 2. The dates for any person who meets the eligibility requirements described in Article II of the City Charter and Section 9-10 of the Code of Ordinances to become a candidate in 2021 for a seat on the City Commission by filing the necessary qualifying papers with the registration and qualifying officer for the City shall run from noon on Monday, January 25, 2021 to noon on Friday, January 29, 2021.

Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
