FOUNDATIONS ACADEMY AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM

### **COMMON DETAILS**

- We have one full-time and one part-time position at all sites to manage our programs. The parttime staff only work in the afternoon during the program.
- Programming is available for students in 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade from the time school is released until 6:00pm.
- Fees: \$19.50 per week (resident); \$29 per week (non-resident) with the exception of Phoenix Community Center. Fees are waived for this site.
- Scholarships are available for those that qualify for free or reduced lunch. There is no cost to those who qualify.
- Weekly Character Counts lesson
- Daily homework time
- Outside play
- Special activities throughout the year
- Snacks are provided daily through a partnership with the Bread of the Mighty Food Bank.

We offer afterschool programming at five locations throughout Gainesville.

#### I. Albert Ray Massey Recreation Center

- ✤ We accept 30 kids in the program. We are currently at capacity.
- We currently have volunteers that come once a month from the Black Students Union, Levins School of Law to interact with the kids.

#### 2. Clarence R. Kelly Community Center

- ✤ We accept 30 kids in the program. We currently have 19 enrollees.
- We have one partnership at this site, the Greater Duval Neighborhood Association. They bring two different programs to the CRK Center.
  - Weekly gardening with Working Food.
  - Science Club that comes bi-weekly through the Cultural Arts Coalition.

#### 3. Eastside Community Center

This site is unique as it has the Cone Park Library as a neighbor. Staff has this constant resource at their fingertips and have a great relationship the ACL staff.
We accept 30 kids in the program. We are currently at capacity.

#### 4. Phoenix Community Center

- ✤ We accept 13 kids in the program. We currently have 11 enrolled.
- This site is available through a partnership with the Gainesville Housing Authority. They have provided us with this apartment that has been converted in to a small recreation center.
- ✤ There is no cost the participants that attend this center.

#### 5. Porters Community Center

- ✤ We accept 30 kids in the program. We currently have 21 enrollees.
- Skybridge Computer Lab
- Future partnership with the Cade Museum

## OUT OF SCHOOL DAYS

Usually are there around 7 to 9 teacher work days throughout the school year. For the majority of these days, we offer full day programming, 7:00am through 6:00pm.

We consolidate staff and reduce down to two sites, Albert Ray Massey and Eastside Community Centers.
