



Goal for today's meeting

Who is GRSL? —

- Largest [only] recreational soccer league in the Gainesville area
- Founded in 1982
- Currently, 605 active players
- Volunteer board monthly meetings

Forest Park is the primary site for games and practices

- One of the only parks in SW Gainesville
- Surrounding area is rapidly developing (Butler Plaza, Celebration Pointe)
- Diversity of housing developments nearby
- Dog park, basketball courts, volleyball courts, pavilions, & 3 full size soccer fields
- Recently transferred from Alachua County to City of Gainesville

...but it does not meet desired standard for parks in Gainesville

- No lightning warning system
- Players cross busy 43rd St. to retrieve balls
- Major need for field re-grading/re-sodding
- Limited parking capacity
- Lack of shade
- Lack of seating & bleachers for each field
- Limited access to water
- No lighting for evening use
- Bathroom facilities may need renovation

What are we asking for?

- Ensure that Forest Park is listed to receive support from Wild Spaces/Public Places this year (obtain votes at March 4 meeting)
- Advocate for capital improvements and maintenance at Forest Park
- Continue discussions with city officials
- Find ways to work with the city to achieve broader shared goals
