**Re:** Pension Review Committee Appointments

There are currently three applicants for two vacancies on the City's Pension Review Committee. The Pension Review Committee (PRC) is a citizen advisory committee that works with the City's Pensions & Investments staff to make investment related recommendations for the General Employees' Retirement Plan to the City Commission as the Board of Trustees for the General Employees' Retirement Plan. Appointment to the PRC requires relevant investment management or advisory experience.

Staff has worked in cooperation with the Pension Review Committee to make PRC appointment recommendations to the Board of Trustees since the PRC's establishment in 1983.

The original Pension Review Committee Resolution R-83-38 states that:

"Applicants to the Pension Review Committee shall have had successful investment experience and proven substantial advisory experience. The preliminary review of the applicants will be conducted by a screening sub-committee consisting of two members of the PRC. The Chairman or designee of the Pension Review Committee shall also be present during the screening review. Applicants will be interviewed by the screening sub-committee and will result in recommendations to the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees for the City's Pension Fund shall appoint the Pension Review Committee."

Over time, PRC applicant interviews were discontinued, and the applicant review process developed to include staff evaluation of PRC applications and resumes. PRC applications are discussed with the Pension Review Committee, and consensus on appointment recommendations is determined. Resulting PRC appointment recommendations are then submitted by staff to the Board of Trustees

Pensions & Investments staff consider the review of PRC applicants to be an important aspect of its Plan administration duties. Appointment of unqualified applicants to the Pension Review Committee may be viewed as a breach of the Board's fiduciary duty, and staff has a responsibility to assist the Board in avoiding such situations.

Staff and the Pension Review Committee have reviewed the current PRC applications and resumes. Based on their backgrounds and investment advisory experience, we recommend appointing the following applicants:

Harvey Lewis – Mr. Lewis currently serves on the City's Pension Review Committee and the Board of Trustees for the Police Officers' and Firefighters' Retirement Plan, and has extensive experience serving on various Florida municipal pension boards and committees advising on the investment of pension plan assets.

Matthew Barker – Mr. Barker is a FINRA licensed investment advisor with significant professional investment management experience.

While we appreciate the other applicant's interest in serving on the PRC, they do not appear to have the investment management experience necessary to make investment recommendations related to the General Employees' Retirement Plan. We therefore cannot recommend the following applicant:

Angelo Witten – Despite having FINRA investigator experience, Mr. Witten has no relevant investment management or advisor experience. He is also a City employee and General Pension Plan member. The Pension Review Committee is a citizen advisory committee, intended to include citizens with professional investment advisory experience. The PRC was never intended to include City employees or Plan members, and until Mr. Witten's partial term appointment in 2019, it never did. There is a separate Pension Advisory Committee that is comprised of City employees & Plan members, which would be more appropriate for Mr. Witten's participation.
