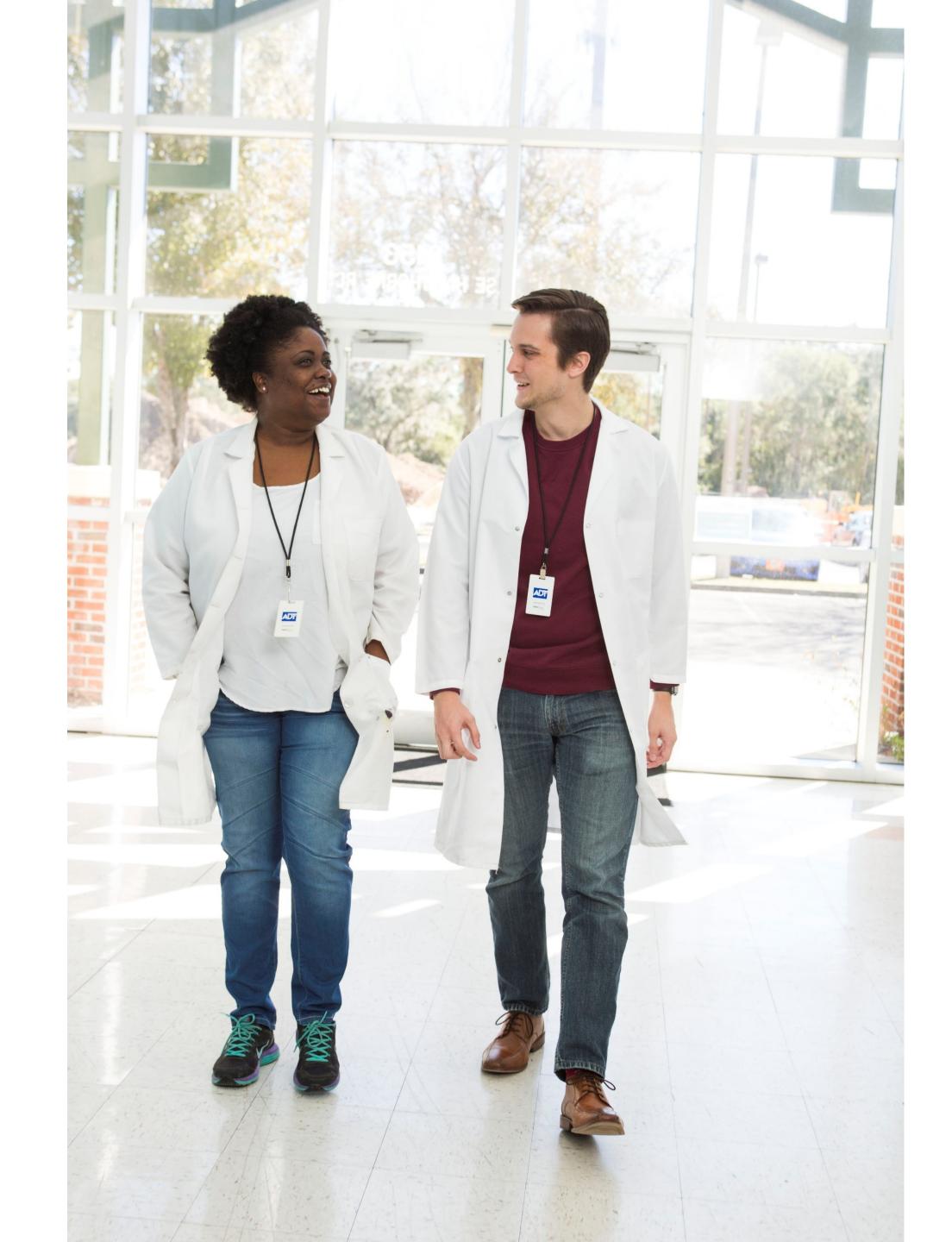

Lessons Learned

- Investments in land/infrastructure in laying a platform for economic development are important but it takes time
- Setting the regulations to facilitate development is necessary but not sufficient
- When setting up an incentive program be mindful of the costs of administration/implementation
- Incentives in and of themselves cannot change market dynamics
 Incentives linked to performance are best
- Addressing talent gaps and building capacity may need to be the focus moving forward
