






GRU Service Areas




Electric Service Area




Gas Service Area




Reclaimed Water Service Area







Electric & Gas Extensions

Electric

- Established Electric Territories
- Extension of Electric Service beyond Electric Territories requires modification of Electric Territories
- Modification of Electric Territories requires agreement with neighboring utility and approval of PSC
- The capital expenditure to complete this process will require City Commission approval

Gas:

 Significant expansions or extensions of the gas system currently require City Commission approval due to level of investment as well as PSC approval



Water & Wastewater Extensions

Water & Wastewater

- Extension of water and wastewater beyond the current service boundary does not require approval from City Commission, since outside city limits
- Alachua County code includes a Urban Cluster Line (coincides with the water/wastewater service boundary)
- Extension of water/wastewater facilities beyond the Urban Cluster Line requires approval from Alachua County BoCC
- Recommend adding a requirement for City Commission approval when extending water/wastewater facilities



Recommendation

 City Commission direct staff to establish a process that requires any extension of water and wastewater services beyond the Alachua County Urban Cluster Line to receive approval from the City Commission prior to receiving a Utility Construction Permit
