


In communities nationwide, the campaign works within three solution areas proven to move the needle on third grade reading proficiency.





What is the **Program Design Evaluation Tool**:

A tool to determine any areas of concern within a program



Transformative Professional Development (TPD)

Program Goal for TPD:

Provide onsite coaching to early childhood teachers on strategies that promote children's language and cognitive development

After Using the Tool, Here is What We Found That Was Working:


Delivery and dosage of the TPD program

After Using the Tool, Here is What We Found That We Could **Enhance**:


A better way to collect and evaluate child assessment data to help measure the impact of TPD and inform ongoing implementation

Knowing This, Here is What We Are **Doing** About It:

Partnering with Alachua County Public School to collect child assessment data and support coaches/teachers to use available data









Next Steps

Engage members of our Campaign for Grade Level Reading in the Community Solutions Action Plan process to identify and align efforts and effects within and across programs in our community.

Use Results Based Accountability framework to gather data that can be used to better align and allocate resources within Alachua County for literacy-based initiatives supporting children birth through grade 3.

Position the Campaign for Grade Level Reading to serve as a "hub" for publicizing and connecting community partners and families to evidence-based literacy supports with clear outcomes.
