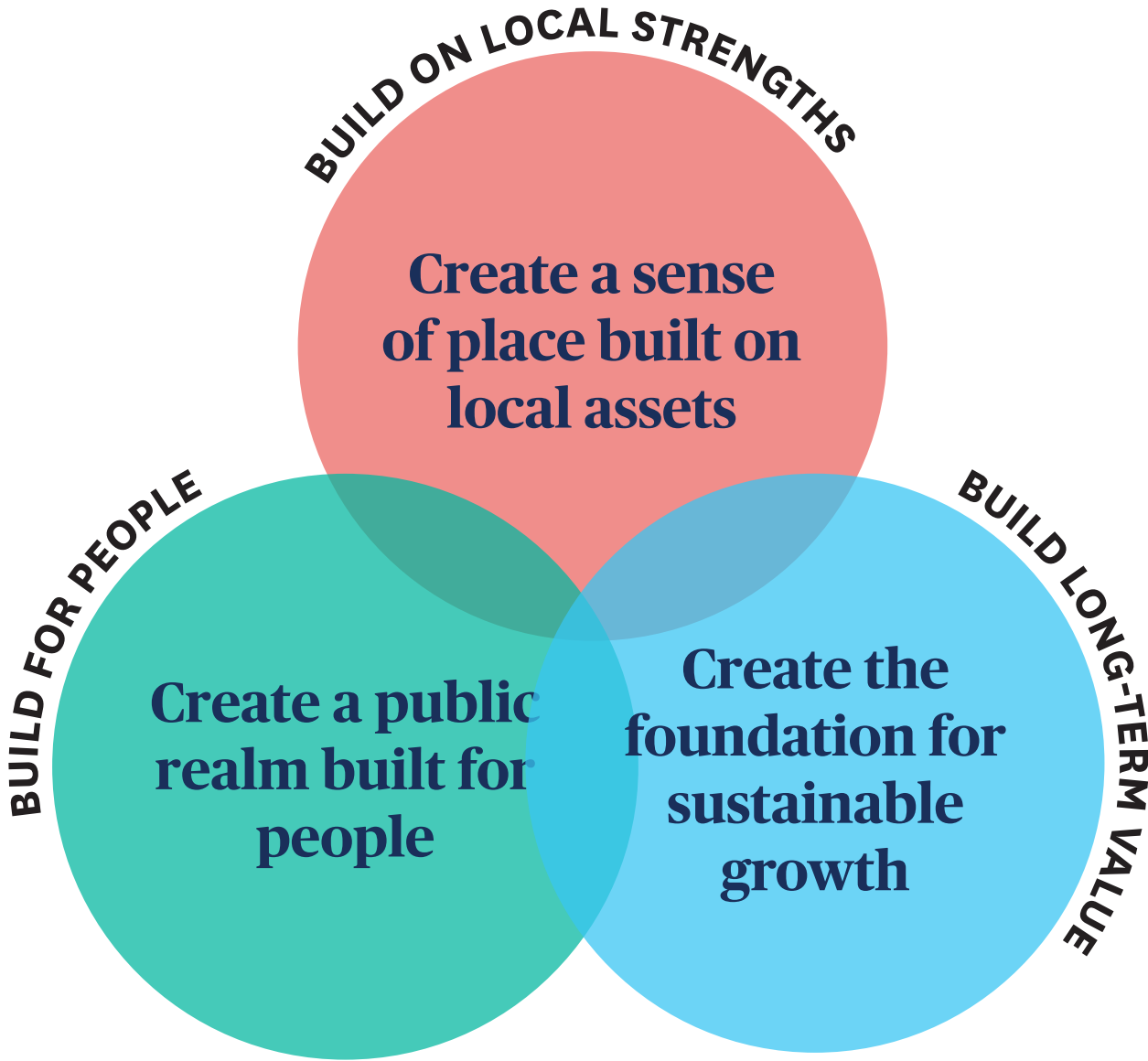

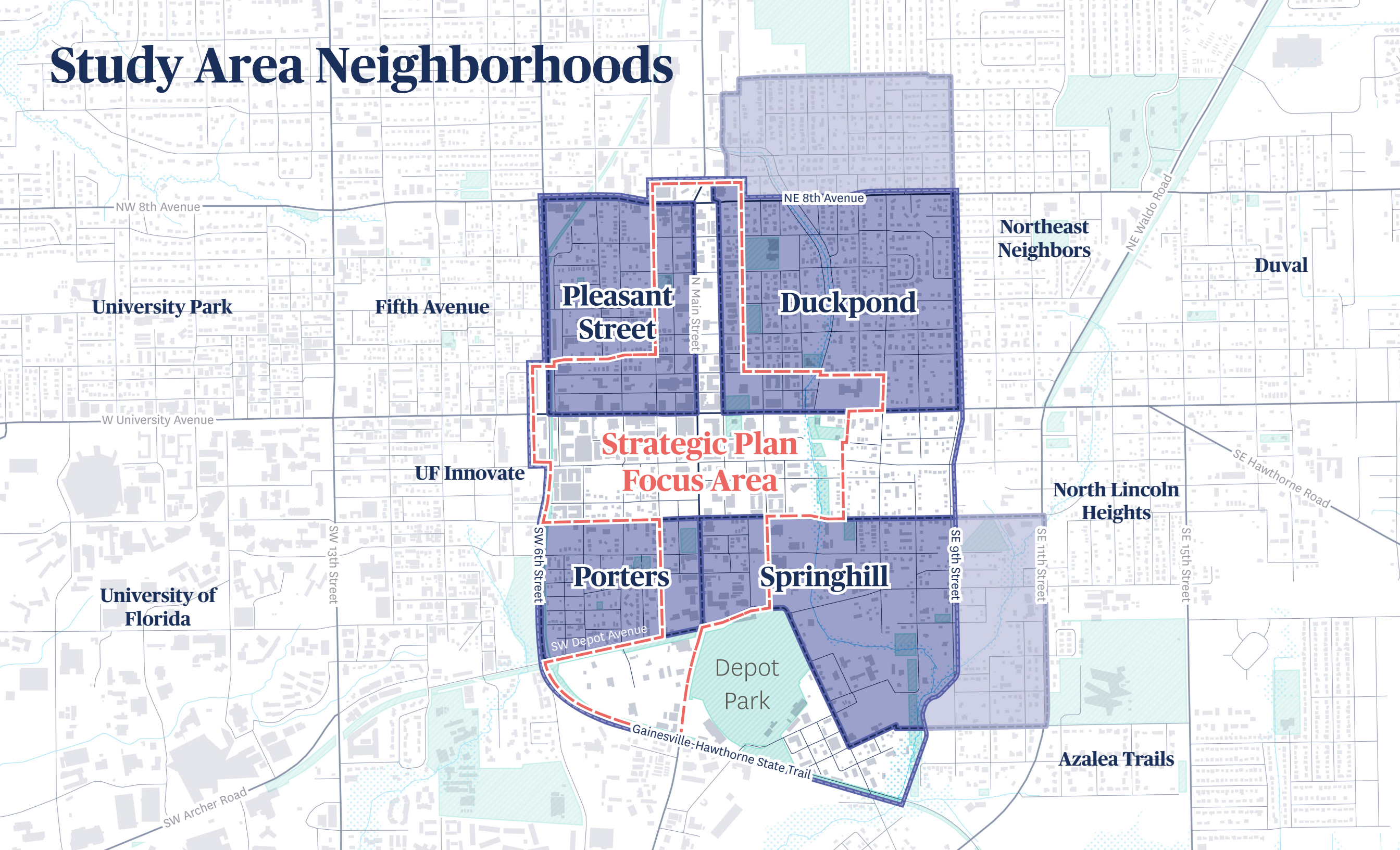
Purpose of the Downtown Strategic Plan

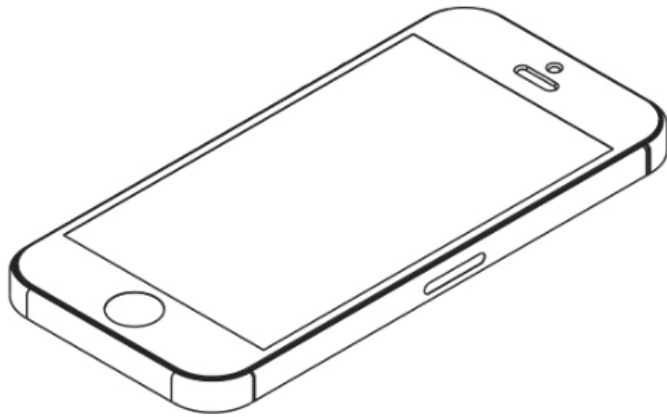

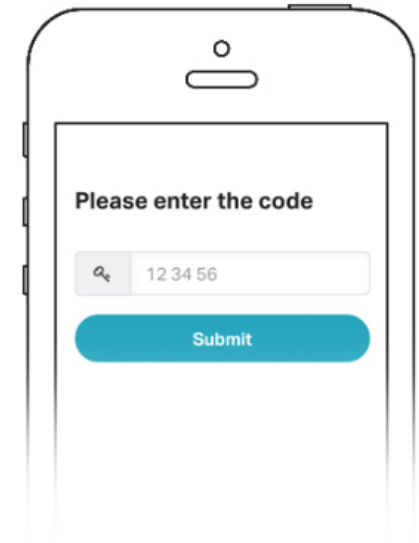
