

**RESOLUTION NO. 210305**

**A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, authorizing the City Manager to execute a Construction and Maintenance Agreement with the State of Florida Department of Transportation for coloring of mast-arms on state roadways inside the city limits.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida Department of Transportation owns traffic signals on the State Highways within the City Limits of Gainesville;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gainesville operates and maintains a City Wide Traffic Management System, Connected and Automated Vehicle Devices;

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida Department of Transportation annually enters into an agreement or amendment with the City of Gainesville for the maintenance of traffic signals and related infrastructure and compensates the City for maintenance;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gainesville wishes to accelerate pedestrian safety projects along West University Avenue / State Road 26; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gainesville wishes to have colored or painted mast-arms (the “Improvement”) consistent with the aesthetics of the university context area, the State of Florida Department of Transportation will do that Improvement at its cost this year and thereafter, the City will be responsible for maintenance and repair of the Improvement.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA THAT:**

**Section 1.** The City Manager is authorized to execute the Construction and Maintenance Agreement, Financial Project ID No: 207658-2-52-01 for coloring or painting of mast-arms on SR 26/West University Ave from Gale Lemerand Drive to NW 14<sup>th</sup> Street, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and legality.

**Section 2.** The City Clerk is directed to provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the State of Florida Department of Transportation at Lake City, Florida.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
