2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12	An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, contracting from the municipal boundaries approximately 2,626 acres of property generally located north of U.S. 441 and NW 53 rd Avenue, east and west of SR 121 and CR 231, and south of NW 121 st Avenue, as more specifically described in this ordinance, pursuant to Chapter 171, Florida Statutes; making certain findings; providing for exclusion of the property in Appendix I of the City Charter; providing for applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations; providing for the apportionment of debts and taxes; providing directions to the City Clerk; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.				
13	WHEREAS, the Municipal Annexation or Contraction Act, Chapter 171, Florida Statutes, (the "Act"),				
14	sets forth criteria and procedures for adjusting the boundaries of municipalities through				
15	annexations or contractions of corporate limits; and				
16	WHEREAS, on April 24, 1992, the City adopted Ordinance No. 3768 and annexed into the City from				
17	Alachua County approximately 460 acres of the southern portion of the property that is the subject				
18	of this ordinance; and				
19	WHEREAS, on February 12, 2007, the City adopted Ordinance No. 060731 and annexed into the City				
20	from Alachua County approximately 1,318 acres of the northern portion of the property that is the				
21	subject of this ordinance; and				
22	WHEREAS, ((we need to include the annexation history of the remaining portions of the total subject				
23	property)); and				
24	WHEREAS, the subject property meets the criteria for contraction under the Act; and				
25	WHEREAS, the City has provided all notices required pursuant to the Act, including: 1) notice that				
26	has been published in a newspaper of general circulation at least once a week for two consecutive				
27	weeks prior to first reading, and which notice gives: a) the ordinance number, b) a brief, general				
28	description of the area proposed to be contracted together with a map clearly showing the area, c)				
29	a statement of findings to show that the area to be contracted fails to meet the criteria of Section				

1	171.043, Florida Statutes, and d) a statement that the ordinance and a complete legal description				
2	by metes and bounds of the contraction area can be obtained from the office of the City Clerk; and				
3	2) not fewer than ten calendar days prior to publishing the newspaper notice, the City Commission				
4	has provided a copy of the notice, via certified mail, to the Alachua County Board of County				
5	Commissioners; and				
6	WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the notice described above during which the				
7	parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.				
8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE,				
9	FLORIDA:				
10	SECTION 1. The City Commission finds that the property described in Section 2 of this ordinance				
11	meets the criteria for contraction of municipal boundaries as set forth in Section 171.052, Florida				
12	Statutes. Specifically, the subject property fails to meet the criteria of Section 171.043, Florida				
13	Statutes, as the subject property:				
14 15	a. is not developed for urban purposes as prescribed by Section 171.043(2), Florida Statutes; and				
16 17 18 19	b. does not lie between the post-contraction municipal boundary and an area developed for urban purposes that is either not adjacent to the post-contraction municipal boundary or cannot be served by the municipality without extending services or water or sewer lines through the subject property; and				
20 21 22 23	c. is not adjacent, on at least 60 percent of its external boundary, to any combination of the post-contraction municipal boundary and the boundary of an area or areas developed for urban purposes.				
24	SECTION 2. The following described property is contracted and excluded from the corporate limits				
25	5 of the City of Gainesville, Florida:				
26 27 28 29	See legal description attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. The location of the property is shown on Exhibit B for visual reference. In the event of conflict or inconsistency, Exhibit A shall prevail over Exhibit B.				

SECTION 3. The corporate limits of the City of Gainesville, Florida, as set forth in Appendix I, Charter
Laws of the City of Gainesville, are amended and revised to exclude the property described in Section
2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Upon the effective date of this ordinance and in accordance with Section 171.062(3), Florida Statutes, the subject property shall no longer be subject to any laws, ordinances, or regulations in force in the City and shall no longer be entitled to the privileges and benefits accruing to the area within the City boundaries, and the subject property shall be subject to all laws, ordinances, and regulations in force in Alachua County.

9 **SECTION 5.** Upon the effective date of this ordinance and in accordance with Sections 171.052(2)

10 and 171.061(2), Florida Statutes, no existing indebtedness or property of the City shall be assumed

11 by Alachua County as a result of this ordinance and the contraction of the subject property.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk is directed to submit a certified copy of this ordinance to the following parties within seven calendar days after the adoption of this ordinance: 1) the Florida Department of State; 2) the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the Eighth Judicial Circuit in and for Alachua County,

15 Florida; and 3) the Chief Administrative Officer of Alachua County.

SECTION 7. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section, or provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding will not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

SECTION 8. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of
such conflict hereby repealed.

23 **SECTION 9.** This ordinance will become effective immediately upon adoption.
