**ORDINANCE NO. 190980** 1 2 3 An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending the Future Land Use Map of the Comprehensive Plan by changing the land use category of 4 approximately 20.73 acres of property generally located northwest of the 5 intersection of SW 43<sup>rd</sup> Street and SW 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue, as more specifically 6 described in this ordinance, from Residential Low-Density (RL) and Residential 7 Medium-Density (RM) to Urban Mixed-Use High Intensity (UMUH); providing 8 9 directions to the City Manager; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date. 10 11 12 WHEREAS, Section 163.3167, Florida Statutes, requires the City of Gainesville to maintain a Comprehensive Plan to guide the future development and growth of the city; and 13 WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan, as required by Section 163.3177(1), 14 15 Florida Statutes, must provide the principles, guidelines, standards, and strategies for the orderly and balanced future economic, social, physical, environmental, and fiscal development 16 of the city as reflected by the community's commitments to implement such plan; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Section 163.3177(6), Florida Statutes, requires the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan to include a Future Land Use Element with a Future Land Use Map that 19 designates the future general distribution, location, and extent of the uses of land for 20 residential, commercial, industry, agriculture, recreation, conservation, education, public 21 facilities, and other categories of the public and private uses of land, with the goals of 22 protecting natural and historic resources, providing for the compatibility of adjacent land uses, 23 and discouraging the proliferation of urban sprawl; and 24 WHEREAS, this ordinance, which was noticed as required by law, will amend the Future Land 25 <sup>26</sup> Use Map of the Comprehensive Plan by changing the land use category of the property that is

27 the subject of this ordinance; and

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28 WHEREAS, this amendment to the Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville 29 Comprehensive Plan proposed herein involves a use of 50 acres or fewer and qualifies as a 30 small-scale development amendment as provided in Section 163.3187, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City Plan Board, which acts pursuant to the authority granted in Section 4.02 of the Charter Laws of the City of Gainesville and which acts as the Local Planning Agency pursuant to Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes, held a public hearing on April 22, 2021, and voted to recommend that the City Commission approve this Future Land Use Map amendment; and

WHEREAS, at least five days' notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and a public hearing held by the City Commission; and

39 WHEREAS, the public hearing was held pursuant to the notice described above at which 40 hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.

41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE,
42 FLORIDA:

43 **SECTION 1.** The Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan is 44 amended by changing the land use category of the following property from Residential Low-45 Density (RL) and Residential Medium-Density (RM) to Urban Mixed-Use High Intensity (UMUH):

46 See legal descriptions attached as **Exhibit A** and made a part hereof as if set 47 forth in full. The location of the property is shown on **Exhibit B** for visual 48 reference. In the event of conflict or inconsistency, **Exhibit A** shall prevail over 49 **Exhibit B**.

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51 **SECTION 2.** The City Manager or designee is authorized and directed to make the necessary 52 changes to maps and other data in the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan in order to 53 comply with this ordinance.

54 **SECTION 3.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section, or provision of this ordinance or 55 the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such 56 finding will not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given 57 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the 58 provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

59 **SECTION 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such 60 conflict hereby repealed on the effective date of this amendment to the Comprehensive Plan.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance will become effective immediately upon adoption; however, the 61 effective date of this amendment to the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan, if not timely 62 challenged, will be 31 days after adoption. If challenged within 30 days after adoption, this 63 amendment will become effective on the date the state land planning agency or the 64 Administration Commission issues a final order determining the amendment to be in 65 compliance with Chapter 163, Florida Statutes. No development orders, development permits, 66 or land uses dependent on this Comprehensive Plan amendment may be issued or commenced 67 before this amendment has become effective. 68




