	 Economic Development and Innovation Director Erik Bredfeldt introduced this agend item. The Florida legislation recently took action to sunset the Enterprise Zone program. The Enterprise Zone is an area of about 10 square miles designated to have a certain threshold for poverty and unemployment. The State offers a menu of incentives that can be applied for prior to December 31, 2015. The City can keep the current Enterprise Zone map, discontinue the program, or potentially realign some of the incentives. Committee members requested the total financial impact of the City programs (business and development fees). The committee members also conceptualized 6th Street as the boundary line between east and west Gainesville for development incentives. The committee members would like to continue this discussion at a future meeting.
