Erik Bredfeldt, Wayne Northcutt, Bill Shepherd and Daniel Hoffman made presentations.

Motion by Commissioner Arreola, seconded by Commissioner Warren: 1) Staff to report back on how General Government would either modify the Real Rate Program or craft a new program that would offer the greater discount in the Enterprize Zone, (start at manufacturing, and to talk to more stakeholders to see what would be meaningful to them, and how it would encourage them to stay here); and 2) Look at the 100 and 400 numbers. Motion passed 7-0.

Motion by Commissioner Arreola, seconded by Commissioner Ward: 1) Flexibility to craft a Real Rate Program that balances the fiscal impact; and 2) As soon as its available bring back to the GPC for final discussion before it goes to the City Commission. Motion passed 7-0.

Commissioner Arreola listed some ideas he had which were: 1) Keep the 50% reduction development fees; 2) Explore the possibility of ridership incentives (property tax abatement, etc); 3) Incentive for every employee that is paid a living wage; 4) possibility of freeloading effect (looking to locate near an Enterprize Zone); and 5) Facade grant.

RECOMMENDATION

The General Policy Committee receive an update on Enterprise Zone Program and provide feedback as appropriate.
