Add resolution/proclamation to the next Commission agenda; and 2) Refer to Clerk (and layer it with the process and discussions that she has been working on with staff) annually legislative breaks.

Motion by Commissioner Hayes-Santos, seconded by Mayor-Commissioner Pro Tem Ward: Reverse the decision on joining the Chamber of Commerce. Motion failed 2-5. Commissioner's Johnson, Warren, Arreola, Simmons and Mayor Poe in dissent.

Commissioner Arreola: Is anyone attending BOOST After School Alliance/Children's Trust meetings. Wants City to get in line for funding requests - City needs a unified message on priorities.

Commissioner Hayes-Santos - Agrees with Commissioner Arreola to lobby BOOST/Children's Trust.

Motion by Commissioner Arreola, seconded by Commissioner Ward: Terminate, without cause, the contract with the City Auditor effective immediately to include 20 weeks' severance pay in accordance with the contract and name the Assistant City Auditor as Interim. Motion passed 5-2. Commissioner's Johnson and Simmons in dissent.

Carlos Holt spoke to the matter.

Commissioner Warren: Wants to do something with the pond outside of City Hall. Dan Hoffman spoke to the matter.

Mayor-Commissioner Pro Tem Ward: Doesn't want to be here, but we are. Hopes as we move forward, we can get the right people in the right place. Requesting that the City Attorney provide a one-pager on how a Charter Officer separates from service.

Commissioner Johnson: Wants to express disappointment that sensitive information was released and the levels of decision making.

Commissioner Warren: Concurs with Commissioner Johnson. We have to learn how to treat each other in a way that we would treat our children, family and friends.
