ALDEN J. GREEN AND LINDA GREEN, INDIVIDUALLY AND FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF NATIONWIDE INSURANCE COMPANY V. CITY OF GAINESVILLE; CASE NO.: 01-00-CA-1729 (B)

The City Commission authorize the City Attorney, and/or special counsel if insurance coverage is available, to represent the City in the case styled Alden J. Green and Linda Green, individually and for the use and benefit of Nationwide Insurance Company v. City of Gainesville.

On or about June 12, 2000, the City was served with a complaint by Alden and Linda Green. They allege Gainesville Regional Utilities failed to use due care in providing electric service to their residence, which resulted in a fire. The Greens and their insurance company request \$29,215.70 in settlement for the damages caused by the fire.
