**Land Rights Resolution - FDOT Project to Upgrade and Renovate the Intersection of Newberry Road and Northwest 39<sup>th</sup> Road (B)**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has an upcoming project to upgrade and renovate the intersection of Newberry Road and Northwest 39<sup>th</sup> Road. FDOT is requiring conveyance of fee title interest for ADA and Signal Improvements.
