BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT REDUCTION IN FEES (B)

Ordinance No. 0-02-14

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending the section entitled "LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE" in Appendix A (Schedule of Fees, Rates, and Charges) of the Code of Ordinances, relating to certain fees for filing petitions before the board of adjustment; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.

The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

At its meeting of April 8, 2002, the City Commission authorized the City Attorney to draft and the Clerk of the Commission to advertise an ordinance reducing board of adjustment fees of \$450.00 to \$225.00. At the direction of the City Manager, the reduction becomes effective on October 1, 2002.
