An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending the Zoning Map Atlas and rezoning certain properties annexed into the City from the Alachua County zoning category of "R-1a, single-family, low density (one to four dwelling units per acre)" and "C-1, conservation district" to the City of Gainesville zoning category of "CON: Conservation district"; as more specifically shown on the maps attached to this ordinance; generally located West of I-75, South and East of SW 30th Avenue and north of the existing City Limits; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
