PANHANDLING RESTRICTIONS (B)

Ordinance No. 0-04-25

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville relating to panhandling; creating and adding Section 19-79 to the Code of Ordinances by providing legislative findings; amending Section 19-80 of the Gainesville Code of Ordinances by prohibiting panhandling, begging or aggressive begging in certain public places; providing directions to the codifier, providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

The City Commission at the regular meeting of February 9, 2004, authorized the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance that expressly provides legislative findings and prohibits panhandling in certain defined public places.
