GAINESVILLE CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD RULES OF PROCEDURE (B)

A resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending the Rules of Procedure for the Gainesville Code Enforcement Board; and providing an effective date.

The City Commission adopt the proposed resolution.

At its meeting of June 12, 2000, the Gainesville Code Enforcement Board amended its Rules of Procedure, creating a new section dealing with reduction or rescission of fines from board orders. Section 30-348 of the Code of Ordinances provides that "**the appropriate board shall by rule or by-laws adopt procedures for the conduct of quasi-judicial proceedings. These procedural rules shall be subject to review and approval of the City Commission.**" **This resolution relates to the Resolution (000174), which proposes to authorize the Mayor to execute satisfactions and releases of liens under certain circumstances.**"
