STORMWATER MANAGEMENT UTILITY FEE INCREASE (B)

ORDINANCE NO. 0-02-34

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Appendix A, "Schedule of Fees, Rates and Charges," Utilities, (6) Stormwater Management, of the Code of Ordinances by increasing the stormwater management utility fee to \$6.25/ERU (Equivalent Residential Unit) for the period commencing October 1, 2002 through September 30, 2003, and to \$6.50/ERU for the period commencing October 1, 2003 and thereafter; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

As part of the budget review process, on July 16, 2002, the City Commission authorized the City Attorney to draft and the Clerk of the Commission to advertise an ordinance increasing the utility fee to \$6.25/ERU (Equivalent Residential Unit) for fiscal year 2003 and \$6.50/ERU for fiscal year 2004. The City Manager is to coordinate billing activities with Gainesville Regional Utilities.
