SALARIES OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSIONERS (B)

Ordinance No. 0-01-69

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Article II of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville relating to salaries of the Mayor and City Commissioners by amending Section 2-66, to reduce said salaries by 13.14 percent; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

At its meeting of January 28, 2002, the City Commission authorized the City Attorney to draft and the Clerk of the Commission to advertise an ordinance reducing the salaries of the Mayor and City Commissioners. The attached ordinance will reduce the salaries of the Mayor and City Commission effective beginning the first full pay period of March 2002. The reduced salaries would thereafter be subject to appropriate CPI adjustments, if any.
