**FY 2011 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Program Continuation (NB)**

The United States Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention has requested that the City of Gainesville apply for funding under the FY 2011 Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force Program Continuation. This funding will allow the continuation of the Gainesville Police Department's North Florida ICAC Task Force which provides equipment, training, and investigative support to agencies investigating crimes involving the victimization of children through the use of technology.

The City is eligible to receive grant funding up to a maximum of \$340,000. No matching funds are required.

The City Commission: 1) authorize the City Manager to apply for these funds; and 2) execute any additional documents as may be required, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney as to form and legality.
