The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

In the Proposed Budget for the Combined Utilities System, the Interim General Manager made a recommendation to increase water base rates, water connection charges and water inspection fees for residential and non-residential customers. Connection charges changes include increased charges for water transmission, distribution and plant connection fees

All changes will be effective October 1, 2006.
