The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

The proposed ordinance which adopts a budget for the City of Gainesville Regional Utilities for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2000 and ending September 30, 2001, to pay for personal services expenses, operating and maintenance expenses and other expenses, for capital outlay and for debt service requirements is submitted for adoption by the City Commission.
