**Resolution to the Department of Transportation - Newberry Road from NW 44th Street to NW 62nd Terrace (B)**

**This item involves a request to adopt a Resolution and authorize the Mayor to execute the Deed to the Florida Department of Transportation for an upcoming project located on Newberry Road from NW 44th Street to NW 62nd Terrace.**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has an upcoming project that is due for upgrades and renovations to various intersections on Newberry Road from Northwest 44<sup>th</sup> Street to Northwest 62<sup>nd</sup> Terrace. This Resolution is for the conveyance of a fee title interest at Northwest 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue at a point of the intersection of Northwest 57<sup>th</sup> Street and running west along the north right-of-way line. The conveyance is for approximately 382 square feet. The conveyance is identified at item 138 on sheet 10 and further portrayed on sheet 18 of the attached maps.

There is no fiscal impact with this request.

The City Commission: 1) adopt the Resolution; and 2) authorize the Mayor to execute the Deed to the Florida Department of Transportation, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality
