The City Commission authorize the City Attorney's Office to represent the City of Gainesville in Fraternal Order of Police, Gator Lodge 67 v. City of Gainesville, Florida, Case Number: 2010-CA-4182.

On August 2, 2010, the City of Gainesville was served with a Summons and Complaint filed by the Fraternal Order of Police, Gator Lodge 67 for declaratory relief. The FOP alleges the City refused to convene a Compliance Review Panel and violated the Law Enforcement Officer's Bill of Rights while conducting two IA investigations. The FOP requests the Court declare that the Gainesville Police Department must convene a Compliance Review Panel to review its actions in IA investigations.
