HOMESTEAD EXEMPTIONS FOR CERTAIN PERSONS 65 AND OLDER (B)

ORDINANCE NO. 0-03-100

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida; creating Article VI of Chapter 25 of the Code of Ordinances, relating to additional homestead exemptions for certain persons 65 and older; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.

The City Commission at its meeting of October 13, 2003, authorized the City Attorney to draft and the Clerk of the Commission to advertise an ordinance adopting an additional homestead exemption for low income seniors, as provided by Section 196.075, Florida Statutes, in the amount of \$20,000, to be effective January 1, 2004, increasing to \$25,000 on January 1, 2005.
