The City Commission at its meeting on May 12, 2003, authorized the City Attorney's Office to draft an amendment relating to our wastewater lateral policy and at its meeting on July 14, 2003, authorized further changes to Chapter 27. Periodically it is necessary to review and revise the provisions of the Code of Ordinances relating to utility service to address new products and services as well as changed business needs. Staff have identified a number of such changes that, in the interest of prudent business operations, will be recommended to be made to a number of provisions affecting the business relationship with customers of the combined utility system. These changes include, but are not limited to, amending the deposit requirements to allow credit checks for residential customers, to restrict refunds of deposits to residential accounts, to address rejected credit card and consumer bank draft payments as well as returned checks, and clarifying certain provisions of the business partners and "retained, expanded and attracted load" rider, tightening up the provisions relating to cross connections, and amending certain service charges.

The City Commission adopt the proposed ordinance.
