**Resolution for the Regional Transit System (RTS) FY2010 Program of Projects (POP) and FY2007-2008 Performance Measures (B)**

**This item is a request to adopt a Resolution authorizing the filing of an application with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).**

In order to remain eligible for federal and state funding, the RTS is required annually to submit a POP to the FTA and a budget application for Capital and Operating projects to the FDOT after seeking public comment. On February 8, 2010, the budget application and RTS Performance Measures for FY2007-FY2008 were published in the Gainesville Sun as required by the FTA. A second meeting notice was advertised on February 16, 2010. A public hearing was held February 23, 2010, and there were no comments from the public.

The costs for the POP in the amount of \$16,779,755 are included in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) approved by the Metropolitan Transportation Planning Organization (MTPO).

The City Commission: 1) adopt the Resolution; and 2) approve the POP for FY2010.
