**Title:** LAND USE CHANGE - ASHTON (B) Ordinance No. 0-00-57; Petition No. 147LUC-99PB An Ordinance amending the City of Gainesville 1991-2001 Comprehensive Plan; by changing the land use categories of certain properties annexed into the City from the Alachua County land use categories to City of Gainesville land use categories as follows: 1) from "Recreation" to "Conservation" on Tax Parcel Nos. 06006-000-000, 06006-001-000, 06022-000-000, 06021-000-000 and 06023-003-001; 2) from "Institutional" to "Office" on Tax Parcel Nos. 06022-002-000 and 06022-001-000; 3) from "Low density residential" to "Single Family (up to 8 units per acre)" on Tax Parcel Nos. 06023-040-001 thru 074 inclusive; 4) from "Institutional" to "Education" on Tax Parcel 06020-002-000; and 5) from "Recreation" to "Agriculture" on Tax Parcel No. 06023-003-002; consisting of approximately 367 acres, located in the vicinity of N.W. 43rd Street north of N.W. 53rd Avenue; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.
