**Title:** AD VALOREM TAX EXEMPTION FOR HISTORIC PROPERTY (B) Ordinance No. 0-00-93 An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, finding that property at 306 NE 7th Street, Gainesville, Florida, qualifies for an ad valorem tax exemption for historic properties; granting an exemption from ad valorem tax on certain improvements beginning January 1, 2001, and continuing for 10 years; adopting the Historic Preservation Exemption Covenant between the applicant and the City by reference; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
