**Title:** CHARTER AMENDMENT - VOTES NECESSARY TO ADOPT AN ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION (B) ORDINANCE NO. 0-03-08 An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida; approving an amendment to the Charter Laws of the City of Gainesville; amending Article II of the Charter Laws, entitled "City Commission", by changing the number of votes required to adopt an ordinance or resolution from three to four; providing for submission of the charter amendment to the voters for approval or disapproval at the April 8, 2003 regular municipal election; approving the question to be placed on the ballot; providing that this charter amendment shall become effective at the first meeting of the seven-member commission in May, 2003 if approved by the voters; providing directions to the codifier; providing directions to the Clerk of the Commission; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
