Title: EXTENSION OF BOUNDARIES FOR ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION DURING EVENTS DOWNTOWN (B) ORDINANCE NO.:0-02-58 An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Article I, Sections 4-4(b)(1) and 4-4(b)(2) of the Code of Ordinances by providing for the extension of boundaries to allow for consumption of alcohol during certain events in the downtown area; provide a limit on the number of permits that may be issued by the city manager during any calendar year; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
