Title: SIDEWALK CAFES IN THE CENTRAL CORRIDOR DISTRICT (B) Ordinance No. 0-00-78; Petition No. 35TCH-00PB An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida; amending subsection 30-66(e)(4) relating to sidewalk cafes in the central corridor district (CCD), providing that a license for a sidewalk cafe, must be renewed upon change of owner of the principal use, revising the requirements and conditions for an enclosure or barrier around the cafe, and revising the requirements for a clear pedestrian path; amending section 30-87 relating to outdoor cafes, revising the requirements and conditions for an enclosure or barrier around the cafe, and requiring the cafe, to not interfere with pedestrian or vehicular circulation; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
