The City Commission authorize the City Attorney and/or special counsel if insurance coverage is available to represent the City of Gainesville and the individual officer in the case styled Chase Nelson vs. the City of Gainesville, Florida, a municipal corporation, and Officer David Reveille, in his individual capacity, Court Case No. 1:12-CV-00113.

On June 4, 2012, the City was served with a Summons and Complaint. The Plaintiff alleges that he is a victim of false arrest, excessive force, and malicious conduct which occurred in 2008. He claims to have suffered severe and permanent injuries, including permanent injuries to his body, psychological damages, pain and suffering, medical expenses, lost wages and loss of ability to earn. Plaintiff is seeking compensatory damages, and attorney's fees and costs.
